Entry of this order has the effect of the filing of the notice of appeal, Rule 809.50(3), Stats., except as follows: The appellant need not file a docketing statement but shall immediately make all necessary arrangements for the preparation of the transcript of the waiver hearing and identify relevant portions of the record to enable the clerk of circuit court to transmit the record to the clerk of this court within 45 days of the date of this order. To assure compliance with this order, the court reporter shall prepare, serve and file the transcript within 20 days of the date arrangements for preparation are made.
