FRO that in any brief filed in this court the parties shall not incorporate by reference any portion of their court of appeals' brief or petition for review or response; instead, any material in these documents upon which there is reliance should be restated in the brief filed in this court; and

FRO that the first brief filed in this court must contain, as part of the appendix, a copy of the decision of the court of appeals in this case; and

FRO that within 30 days after the date of this order, each party must provide the clerk of this court with 10 copies of the brief previously filed on behalf of that party in the court of appeals;

FRO that Attorney Dean A. Strang shall serve as counsel for defendant-appellant-petitioner, Michael A. Sveum. Attorney Strang's representation shall be on a pro bono basis and not subject to compensation under SCR ch. 81. The court notes that Michael A. Sveum has given his consent to be represented by Attorney Strang; and

FRO that the allowance of costs, if any, in connection with the granting of the petition will abide the

decision of this court on review.
