IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days after the date of this order the appellant must file a brief in this court; that within 20 days of filing the respondent must file a brief; and that within 10 days of filing the appellant must file either a reply brief or a statement that no reply brief will be filed; and IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties will be notified of the date and time for oral argument in this appeal in due course.

REBECCA GRASSL BRADLEY, J. (concurring). I concur with the court's decision in this case to grant the Attorney General's petition to bypass the court of appeals; the respondent joins the request for this court to expedite appellate review. This case presents purely legal issues of statutory interpretation, which implicate the separation of powers. I write separately to highlight the court's inconsistency in following its purported practice of denying petitions to bypass prior to the filing of briefs in the court of appeals, which it sometimes deems "premature"except when it doesn't. [...] I am authorized to state that ANNETTE KINGSLAND ZIEGLER, C.J., and PATIENCE DRAKE ROGGENSACK, J., join this concurrence.

REBECCA FRANK DALLET, J. (concurring). I write separately to clarify the reasons for granting the petition for bypass even though the parties have yet to file their principal briefs with th
